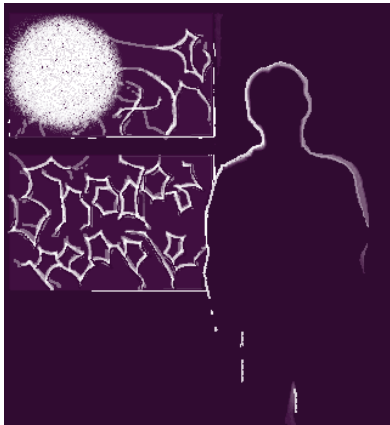

During the Spring of 2005 CPRI had something very exciting happen. We received a case from 3 separate locations within a mile of each other. These cases were submitted independently and the submitters weren't aware of other people having the same ghostly phenomena occurring at the adjacent locations. What is even more fascinating about these cases is that they are all reporting the same phenomena—shadow people. What's even more interesting about this phenomena is that the "shadow people" seem to

hide when someone spots them—as if they don't want to be seen. This phenomena has been reported at 4 separate locations—including a church. The Winterpock area has a long history of tragedy because that entire area was a mining facility where many miners lost their lives of the nearly 300 years of mining in the area. CPRI conducted its 1st FOI at the location in May and hopes to continue investigating this area for a long time. Check out the website for updates.
